What is it?

The Panther Degree Pathway (PDP) is a semester by semester planner that generates the optimal path to completion. The PDP is personalized to each FIU student – no two plans are alike. Students can drag & drop courses while also editing semesters. The PDP offers clear notifications if the students departs from their recommended optimal path.

How does it look?
